April 18, 2004, 3<sup>rd</sup> degree at Columbus Hall on Home Avenue.

April 22, 2004, Religious Appreciation Dinner – Pick up and bring your Religious to the dinner. Tell them to leave their wallets at home. We are the host. Buy their dinner and their drinks. Then take them home and tell them thank-you.

April 24, 2004, Past Chapter Presidents Dinner – Show support for those who served our chapter so well.

April 25, 2004, Horseshoe meeting at Regina Coeli Hall in Escondido. All State Convention delegates need to attend.

The state convention is fast approaching. You need to make your reservation soon. We need to support Brother Robert Villalobos who is running for State Warden. This is the first chair in the progression to State deputy.

**Chapter Chaplain – Father Vincent Lorenz** – Thank you for your prayers. The knees are feeling better. I saw the Passion of the Christ. It shows the way it was. We are in the Lenten Season. It is a time of self-denial. We should observe the rules of the church regarding fasting and Abstinence.

### **Retention – John Giltner**

#### ***RETENTION IS EVERY KNIGHT'S JOB***

The procedure we all hate to go through, but must when necessary. Do it at the proper time.

Form 1845 “Notice of Intent to Suspend” procedure:

1. Member is identified as in arrears. Financial Secretary provides the list to the Retention Committee at the membership section of the Council meeting.
2. Retention Committee reports on previous month's calls/activity.
3. GK must insure that proper contact has been made with a delinquent member. Only then will the 1845 process begin. It is very

important that the form is completed properly, especially the phone number.

4. All four copies should be mailed on the same date they are prepared.
5. DD gets DD copy – he will contact the member in an attempt to save him. DD insures 1845 process properly followed by all councils in his district:
6. State council copy is to be sent directly to the Chapter's State membership committeeman. Committeeman contacts the member in an attempt to save him. Committeeman keeps a log and sends monthly a copy to the State Retention Chairman.
7. 30 days later – Form 100 – suspension is prepared. All Forms 100's get mailed to the State Retention Chairman who will forward them to the Supreme office after verifications are made based on Committeeman's monthly log.

**Essay Contest- Bernie Gardner** – Sixteen essays received from seven councils. Essays were excellent, but next year we need to get more councils involved.

**Supreme Director – Joe Schultz** – The top person in a volunteer organization should be the busiest. Knights in California provided \$141,000 to support vocations through the RSVP program. The San Diego Diocese chapter contributed \$26,950. RSVP is a program to provide moral support to seminarians. We also need to send cards of encouragement. Invite them to council meetings and events. They are our future Religious leaders. We need a strong push in membership during the last part of the Columbian year. Ask someone to join before the year is over. Ask yourself if you are doing a good job. Are you satisfied the way you are doing your job? If you say yes, than you should quit. You should always try a little harder, reach a little farther and try to accomplish a little more.
