Please come and feel free to invite family and friends.

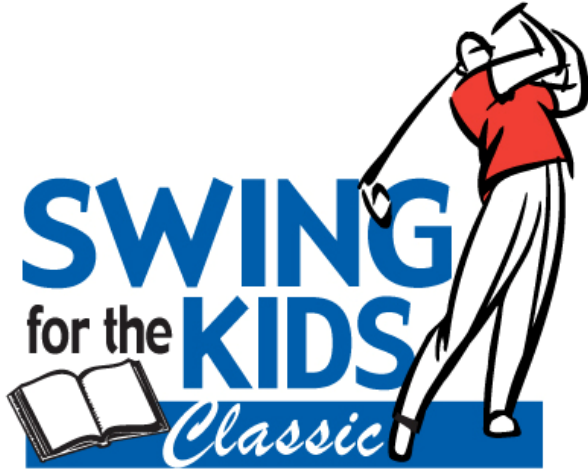

Dear Fellow Knights:

Our Golf Committee is kicking into high gear as we have finished our website (www.swingforthekids.com), and we have kicked off our fundraising efforts by contacting not only last year's Sponsors, but new ones this year as well. 2006 Tournament Sponsor Request Letter

Dear Fellow Brother Knight:

Our Golf Committee has been planning and dedicating ourselves to the 11th Annual Swing for the Kids Classic, the premier golf tournament, banquet dinner, and live auction for N.E. San Diego County, to raise funds for our favorite charity, St. Michael School.

As part of that event, one of the most important things we need for a successful event are **sponsors** who contribute funds and/or goods & services which help defray the costs of running the tournament.
