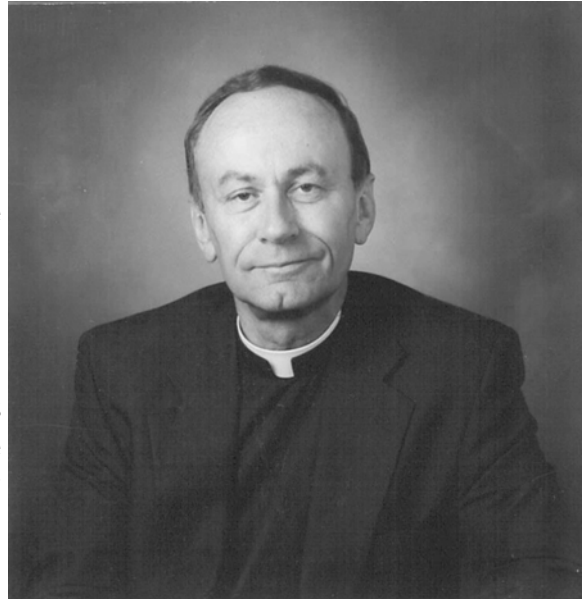

Dear Worthy Brothers:

As **Brother Bryan Dolejs** mentioned, we're looking for a Brother Knight to take over the position of **Financial Secretary** in the new Columbian Year, starting July 1, 2010. Our Supreme Council asks that this be a three-year commitment, although that is not mandatory. I've enjoyed this duty very much, but I've told my fellow Council Officers that I will complete my 3-year term, which ends on June 30, 2010, and then step down. 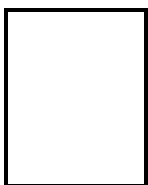
